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### 1 Opening

### (i) ISP survey

#### (i) New head of department

• The process has begun. Esmée has collected thoughts from PhD students on what is important to consider in the recruitment process according to us, and attended two meetings with the recruitment group.

### 6 Updates from other meetings

### (i) Institutionsrådsmöte (advisory board meeting)

- It was discussed how to increase the visibility of the Department of Physics.
- It was discussed that informal or perceived requirements for the number of articles needed in a thesis are causing stress among PhD students, while there is no formal requirement about the quantity but rather about the quality. This might be good to clarify.
- The results from the employee survey were discussed, and the results are in general quite positive for the department. In particular, the Department of Physics is the best at Chalmers when it comes to gender balance in the responses (measured as the difference between the mean answer to a question from all female respondents and the mean answer from all male respondents).

## 7 Other matters

- The General Assembly will be held on the 6th of December.
- The next Doctoral Evaluation meeting will be held on the 17th of December. Björn will attend this, and stay on as PhD student representative in the final parts of this project even though he is leaving the board. The outcome of the Doctoral Evaluation process will be an action plan and the next board will keep in close contact with Björn in order to keep up to date with this matter.
